Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting - #0249 Final Minutes

The Regular Meeting of the Port Ludlow Drainage District (PLDD) was called to order by Chair Don Forbes at 10:00 a.m. on June 13, 2019, at the Training Room of the Port Ludlow Fire & Rescue Headquarters Fire Station 31, 7650 Oak Bay Road, Port Ludlow, Washington 98365.

 - **a.** Engineer Nancy Lockett gave a report and summation of the work that was done by Olympic Peninsula Construction on the Condon Lane Outfall Repair. The PLDD has met the intent of its requirement to approve the project. (Handout No. 1)
