APPOINTMENT OF AN AGENT TO RECEIVE CLAIMS (RCW 4.96.020)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 4.96.020 the governing body of each local governmental entity shall appoint an agent to receive any claim for damages made under chapter 4.96RCW. The identity of the agent and the address where he or she may be reached during normal business hours of the local government entity are public records and shall be recorded with the auditor of the county in which the entity is located. All claims for damages against a local governmental entity, or against any local governmental entity's officers, employees, or volunteers, acting in such capacity, shall be presented to the agent within the applicable period of limitations within which an action must be commenced. The failure of a local governmental entity to comply with the requirements of this section precludes that local governmental entity from raising a defense under chapter 4.93 RCW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of the Port Ludlow Drainage District appoint the below listed agent to receive any claims for damages made under chapter 4.96 RCW.
